DESCRIPTION:

Grays Harbor College is seeking a talented, energetic, and dedicated psychology faculty member with primary teaching responsibility in its Psychology Department. Applicants must have a minimum of a Master's in Psychology or a related field and experience teaching psychology. This position's primary responsibility will include teaching General Psychology (PSCY& 100). The opening is for a morning class Winter Quarter 2017 (January through March) located at the Riverview Education Center in Raymond, WA. The successful candidate will be expected to participate actively in affairs of the Social Sciences Division as needed. This is a part-time temporary position. The salary is \$593.47 per quarter load hour (\$2,967 for a five-credit class).

All faculty at Grays Harbor College are represented by the Grays Harbor College Federation of Teachers, Local 4984 and you are required to join GHCFT or pay an agency fee as a condition of employment. Information about paying union dues or equivalent amounts will be provided to you as part of the payroll documents you need to fill out a new GHC employee. The faculty union and the college have a bargaining unit agreement (referred to as the contract) that is posted on the GHC at <http://www.ghc.edu/sites/default/files/pictures/HR/agreement.pdf>.

- Teach students essential skills involved in mastering course work in the field of Psychology, create lectures and assignments that support the curriculum, understand and present current research in the field.
- Create a classroom environment conducive to learning that meets the needs of students and employs appropriate instructional methods.
- Collaborate with other faculty in the selection of learning resources (including texts and software) to support curriculum.
- Work effectively with individuals from diverse backgrounds.
- Participate fully in course level outcomes assessment.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's degree in Psychology
- Demonstrated ability to teach the assigned coursework
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively with diverse populations

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Experience teaching College Level Psychology
- Experience using computers and other technologies in instruction.
- Experience teaching at a community college.
